Y N Access

- Clearly marked entrance
- Park & set brake before exiting
- Get Out And Look – G.O.A.L.
- Spotters or traffic control available
- CMV accessible
- Entrance & jobsite free of obstructions

Y N Pedestrians/Customers Onsite

- Pedestrians, inspectors, lab techs, finishers, laborers, contractors alert of your presence
- Hand signals discussed
- Chute safety awareness discussed
- Spotters visible – IF NOT, STOP!
- Pedestrians safely using mobile devices
- Customers aware of pressurized pump line movement/whipping hazards
- Customers aware they must assist with pump line assembly/disassembly/cleaning

Y N Overhead Hazards (Min. Clearance 14')

- Boom pump or belt truck overhead
- Utility wires – 20' minimum clearance
- Scaffolding, lifts, cranes, falling objects
- Building eaves or low overhangs
- Low overhead doorways
- Trees

Y N Designated traffic pattern

- Clearly marked routes to entrances/exits
- Designated staging areas
- Designated wash out/clean out areas

Y N Ground Hazards

- Customer aware of & accepts possible rutting
- Culverts, ditch/creek crossings
- Ground conditions – soft soil, mud, ice, slope
- Underground/ground level utilities - i.e. drain fields, septic tanks, gas/water/sewage lines
- Sidewalks, Driveways, Landscaping
- Open excavation – use 1:1 foot relief rule
- Jobsite clutter – tools, lumber, etc.

Y N Traffic

- Delivering in/near moving traffic/work zone
- Jobsite construction traffic (yield to other jobsite equipment)
- Railroad crossings

Y N Driver Physical Hazards

- Identify surface hazards on & around the truck to prevent slips & trips
- Wear ALL job specific PPE
- Maintain 3-pts of contact
- Use proper lifting techniques
- Pinch point awareness – chutes, rollers
- Maintain safe distance of moving equipment
- Extreme heat or cold temperatures

Our driver is also required to obtain an owner or responsible party signature on their ticket to authorize entry into your jobsite. The Site Risk Assessment and owner or responsible party signature of entry authorization are required and should only take a few minutes to complete.
